WOORINEN SOUTH & DISTRICT

Woorinen South and District is a community of some 600 people (2016 Census) located 10kms to the North West from Swan Hill. The area is surrounded in horticulture farms, producing a variety of cereal grains, stone fruits, grapes (wine and table), nuts and vegetables. During the season, fruit freshly picked from the trees is available for sale direct to the public.

The community of Woorinen South and District supports a Pre-School with a Maternal Health Centre attached and a thriving Primary School with around 90 students. We have a Post Office/General Store, local Tavern and a privately owned historical museum within Woorinen South and District, which is available for viewing by appointment.


